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Please read the instructions carefully before starting this project. If kitting it is recommended a sample is made to confirm accuracy.

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Cutting Instructions

Notes:

- Please be sure to check *blankquilting.net* for pattern updates prior to starting the project.
- All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

Fabric A, cut:

Fussy-cut (6) 11½" squares

Fabric B, cut:

(5) 4½" x WOF; subcut
(9) 4½" x 18½"

Fabric C, cut:

(1) 11½" x WOF; subcut
(3) 11½" squares

Fabric D, cut:

(7) 5½" x WOF

Fabric E, cut:

(3) 2½" x WOF; subcut
(9) 2½" x 13½"

Fabric F, cut:

(3) 2½" x WOF; subcut
(9) 2½" x 11½"
(9) 2½" squares

Fabric G, cut:

(5) 4½" x WOF; subcut
(9) 4½" x 14½"
(9) 4½" squares

Fabric H, cut:

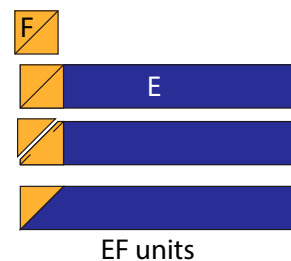
(10) 2½" x WOF
(8) 2½" x WOF for binding
(3) 2½" x WOF; subcut
(6) 2½" x 18½"
(8) 1½" x WOF; subcut
(9) 1½" x 14½"
(9) 1½" x 13½"

Sewing

All seam allowances are ¼". Sew pieces right sides together. Press seam allowances open unless otherwise indicated.

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 2½" **Fabric F** square. Place the marked square right sides together on the left end of (1) 2½" x 13½" **Fabric E** rectangle (**Fig. 1**). Stitch on the drawn line, trim seam allowance to ¼", and press open. Make (9) total EF units.

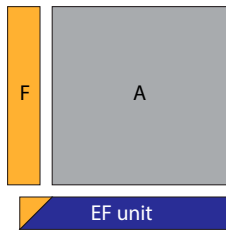


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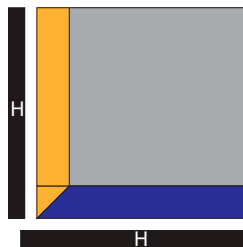
- Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $11\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric F** rectangle to the left side of (1) $11\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric A** square. Sew (1) EF unit to the bottom (**Fig. 2**).

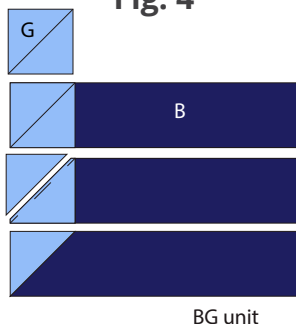
- Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $13\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric H** rectangle to the left side of the unit from Step 2. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $14\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric H** piece to the bottom (**Fig. 3**). Unit will measure $14\frac{1}{2}$ " square.

- Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric G** square. Place the marked square right sides together on the left end of (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $18\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric B** rectangle (**Fig. 4**). Stitch on the drawn line, trim seam allowance to $\frac{1}{4}$ ", and press open. Make (9) total BG units.

- Sew (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $14\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric G** rectangle to the left side of the unit from step 4. Sew (1) BG unit to the bottom to make (1) block (**Fig. 5**). Make a total of (6) Block #1. In the same way, make (3) Block #2 using $11\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric C** squares (**Fig. 6**). Blocks will measure $18\frac{1}{2}$ " square.

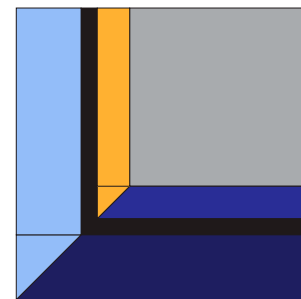
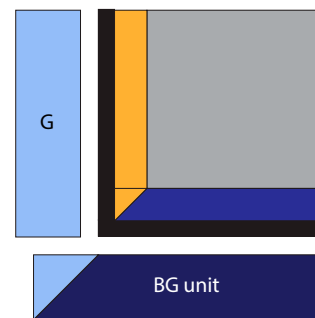
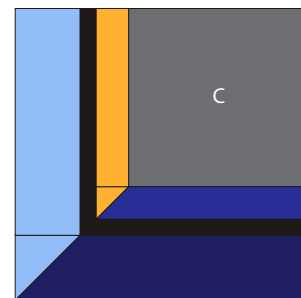

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Quilt Top Assembly

Follow the Quilt Layout on Page 6 while assembling the quilt top.

6. Sew together (3) blocks, alternating with (2) 2½" x 18½" **Fabric H** pieces, noting orientation of blocks. Repeat to make a total of (3) rows measuring 58½" x 18½".
7. Sew the (10) 2½" x WOF **Fabric H** strips together end to end into a continuous strip and press open. Cut (2) 2½" x 62½" and (4) 2½" x 58½" lengths. Sew together (3) block rows, alternating with (4) 2½" x 58½" **Fabric H** strips. Sew 2½" x 62½" **Fabric H** strips to the left and right sides.
8. Sew (7) 5½" x WOF **Fabric D** strips together end to end into a continuous strip and press open. Cut (2) 5½" x 72½" and (2) 5½" x 62½" lengths.
9. Sew 5½" x 62½" **Fabric D** side borders to the quilt center, and then sew the 5½" x 72½" top/bottom borders to the quilt top.

Finishing

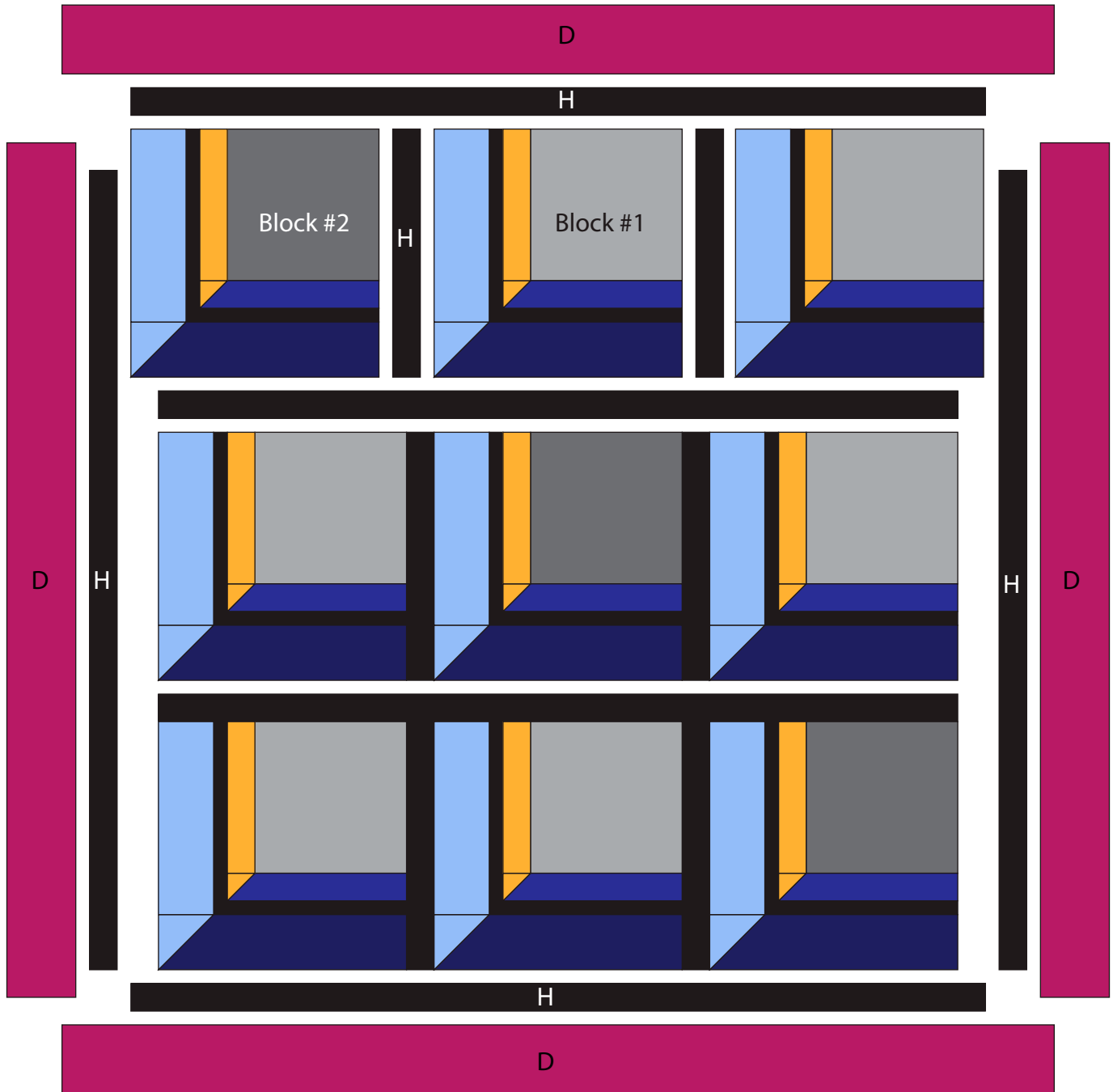
10. Sew together the (8) 2½" x WOF **Fabric H** binding strips end to end using diagonal seams. Press the seams open. Press the binding strip in half, wrong sides together.
11. Trim the selvage edges from the backing fabric. Cut the yardage into two equal lengths and use a ½" seam to sew the sections together along one long edge to make the quilt backing. Press.
12. Layer the backing (wrong side up), batting, and quilt top (right side up). Baste the layers together and quilt as desired. Trim excess batting and backing even with the top of the quilt.
13. Leaving an 8" tail of binding and beginning along an edge of the quilt top, match raw edges of the binding to the raw edges of the quilt top. Sew the binding to the outside edge around all four sides and miter corners. Stop sewing approximately 12" from where you started and backstitch.
14. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along the quilt edge. Where these two loose ends meet, fold them back onto themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding together, right sides matching. Trim seam to ¼" and press seam open. Finish sewing the binding to the quilt top.
15. Turn the binding over the raw edge to the back of the quilt and hand or machine stitch in place.
