

- 100% cotton thread in colors to match
- 89" x 89" (2.26m x 2.26m) batting



Cutting

WOF = Width of Fabric LOF = Length of Fabric

Note: Cut the fussy-cut rectangles so the longer dimension is parallel to the selvage (along the LOF).

From Fabrics A, B, D, and E-L, fussy cut from each:

- (1) 6" wide x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " high rectangle, centered on a large motif as best as possible
- (1) 4" wide x 6" high rectangle, featuring a small motif or to continue the pattern in the large motif

From Fabric C, fussy cut:

- (2) 6" wide x 91/2" high rectangles, centered on a large motif
- (2) 4" wide x 6" high rectangles, featuring a small motif or to continue the pattern in the large motif
- (10) 51/4" x WOF strips for border

From Fabric M, cut:

(21) 3" x WOF; subcut (84) 3" x 9½"

From Fabric N, cut:

(3*) 3" x WOF; subcut (40) 3" x 3"

*1 more WOF strip may be needed, depending on how efficiently you cut.

From Fabric O, cut:

- (4) 4" x WOF; subcut (36) 4" x 4"
- (4) 2" x WOF; subcut (72) 2" x 2"
- (3) 1½" x WOF; subcut (72) 1½" x 1½"

From Fabric P, cut:

(12) 1¾" x WOF; subcut (264) 1¾" x 1¾"

From Fabrics Q-T and V-AL, cut from each:

- (1) 6" x 9½"
- (1) 4" x 6"

From Fabric U, cut:

- (2) 6" x 9½"
- (2) 4" x 6"
- (10) 21/2" x WOF for binding

From Fabrics AM-AU, cut from each:

- (1) 3" x WOF; subcut
 - (1) 3" x 3"
 - (8) 1¾" x 1¾"




Instructions


All seam allowances are ¼" and pieces are sewn right sides together. Press seam allowances following the short arrows in the diagrams.

1. Mark a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of all the **Fabric O** 1½" and 2" squares. Pin a marked 1½" square on the upper left-hand corner and a marked 2" square in the upper right-hand corner of each **Fabric A-L** and **Q-AL** 6" x 9½" rectangle, noting orientation of marked lines and directional fussy cuts as shown. Sew on the marked lines. Trim the seam allowance to ¼" and press towards the corners to complete Unit A. Make 36 total.




2. Pin a marked **Fabric O** 1½" square on the upper left-hand corner and a marked 2" square on the bottom left-hand corner of each **Fabric A-L** and Q-AL 4" x 6" rectangle as shown. Sew, trim, and press as in step 1, then sew a **Fabric O** 4" x 4" square to the top to complete Unit B. Make 36 total.



3. Sew a matching Unit A and Unit B together as shown to make a Heart Block. Make (1) block each with Fabrics A, B, D, E-L,Q-T, and V-AL, and (2) blocks each with Fabrics C and U.




4. Mark a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of all the Fabric P 1¾" squares. Pin a marked Fabric P square on the corner of a Fabric M 3" x 9½" strip as shown. Sew, trim, and press as in step 1. Repeat with all remaining corners to make Sashing A. Make 48 total.

6. Sew (6) Sashing A and (7) **Fabric N** 3" x 3" squares together to make a sashing row. Make (4) and label Sash Rows 1, 3, 5, and 7.

7. Arrange (2) each of Fabrics AN, AU, and AS Sashing B with (4) Fabric N and 1 each Fabrics AN, AU, and AS 3" x 3" squares as shown. Sew together to make Sash Row 2, and press as in Sash Row 1. Repeat to make Sash Row 4 with Fabrics AQ, AP, and AM, and Sash Row 6 with Fabrics AT, AR, and AO.

Repeat step 4 to make 4 each of Sashing **B**, replacing the bottom 2 corner squares with pairs of marked 13/4" squares of **Fabrics AM-AU**.









Finishing

- **8.** Refer to the **Quilt Layout** diagram (page 9) to arrange the blocks in 6 rows of 6 blocks each, rotating the blocks as shown. Arrange the Sash Rows 1-7 above and below the block rows in numerical order, then add in vertical Sashing A and B units in the block rows, making sure all the star point fabrics in the vertical sashing units match the adjacent pieces in the sash rows.
- **9.** Sew the sashing units and blocks together into rows. Press towards the blocks.
- 10. Pin sashing rows to block rows, matching seam intersections, and sew together to complete the quilt center ($75\frac{1}{2}$ " square). Press towards the sash rows.
- 11. Sew together all the **Fabric D** border strips end to end with straight seams. Press open. Cut into 4 strips each 91" long. Fold each border strip in half, matching the short ends, and mark the center along the bottom edge of the fussy-cut motif. This is the edge that will be sewn to the quilt center. Then mark the centers of the top and bottom of the quilt center. Pin the top border to the top of the quilt center, matching the centers, and making sure the top of the motifs are facing away from the quilt center. Sew, beginning and ending the seam ½" from the sides of the quilt center. Repeat to add the bottom border, with the top of the motifs again facing away from the quilt center.



12. Press the top and bottom borders away from the quilt center. Repeat the previous step to add the side borders so that the top of the motifs will be facing away from the quilt center.

13. Fold the quilt top RST diagonally through a corner, making sure the border seams are aligned from the folded corner outwards. Draw a 45° line extending from the fold on the border piece that is on top, then stitch on the line (**Fig. 8c**). Open the corner up to check from the right side that the miter will lay flat when pressed open, then trim seam allowance to ¼". Repeat the process to miter the remaining 3 corners. Press seam allowances open.

Finishing

- **14.** Sew together the 2½" **Fabric U** binding strips end-to-end using diagonal seams. Press seams open. Press the binding strip in half wrong sides together.
- **15.** Layer backing (wrong side up), batting, and quilt top (right side up). Baste the layers together and quilt as desired. Trim excess batting and backing even with the top after quilting is completed.
- 16. Leaving an 8" tail of binding, sew the binding to the top of the quilt through all layers matching all raw edges. Miter corners. Stop approximately 12" from where you started. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along quilt edge. Where the loose ends meet, fold them back on themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding right sides together. Trim seam to ¼" and press open. Finish sewing binding to quilt.
- **17.** Turn the binding to the back of quilt and handstitch in place.
