

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# **Timeless Trails**

Fabric collection by FootePrint Art Ski Run Quilt designed by Lisa Swenson Ruble Finished size approximately: 61" x 61"

## Yardage:

Fabric A	TTRA6004-N	2/3 yard (1 panel)
Fabric B	TTRA6005-MU	1 5/8 yards
Fabric C	TTRA6006-B	2/3 yard
Fabric D	TTRA6006-E	1/8 yard
Fabric E	TTRA6009-N	2 1/4 yards
Fabric F	TTRA6009-R	1/2 yard
Backing		4 yards
Batting		69" x 69"

## **Cutting Instructions:**

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. Strips are cut across the width of fabric **WOF** (perpendicular to selvedges) unless otherwise stated. All seams are sewn with 1/4" seam unless otherwise stated. Label all pieces.

#### Fabric A:

 Fussy cut eight 9 1/2" squares each centered on a block. (Blocks)

#### Fabric B:

- Cut two 5 1/2" x 51 1/2" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips. (Outer Border)
- From the remaining fabric cut two 5 1/2" x 61 1/2" strips, piece as needed. (Outer Border)
- Cut one 9 1/2" square. (Blocks)

#### Fabric C:

 Cut eight 2 1/2" x WOF strips; sub-cut twenty-four 2 1/2" x 12 1/2" rectangles. (Sashing)

#### Fabric D:

 Cut one 2 1/2" x WOF strip; sub-cut sixteen 2 1/2" squares. (Cornerstones)

#### Fabric E:

- Cut one 3" x WOF strip; sub-cut eight 3" squares.
  (Pieced Border)
- Cut seven 2 1/2" x WOF strips. (Binding)
- Cut four 2 1/2" x WOF strips; sub-cut twelve 2 1/2" x 12 1/2" rectangles and four 2 1/2" squares. (Pieced Border)
- Cut six 2" x WOF strips; sub-cut eighteen 2" x 12 1/2" rectangles. (Blocks)
- Cut five 2" x WOF strips; sub-cut eighteen 2" x 9 1/2" rectangles. (Blocks)
- Cut five 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut two 2" x 51 1/2" strips and two 2" x 48 1/2" strips. (Inner Border)


#### Fabric F:

- Cut one 3" x WOF strip; sub-cut eight 3" squares.
  (Pieced Border)
- Cut three 2 1/2" x WOF strips; sub-cut forty-eight 2 1/2" squares. (Sashing)

## Piecing Instructions:


Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations while assembling the various components.

1. Sew one 2" x 9 1/2" **Fabric E** rectangle to each side of one 9 1/2" **Fabric A** square. Sew one 2" x 12 1/2" **Fabric E** rectangle to the top and bottom of the **Fabric A** square to make one 12 1/2" Block One square. (Diagram 1) Repeat to make an additional seven Block One squares.



Make (8) = 12 1/2" x 12 1/2" unfinished Diagram 1

Sew one 2" x 9 1/2" Fabric E rectangle to each side of one 9 1/2" Fabric B square. Sew one 2" x 12 1/2" Fabric E rectangle to the top and bottom of the Fabric B square to make one 12 1/2" Block Two square. (Diagram 2)




Make (1) = 12 1/2" x 12 1/2" unfinished Diagram 2


3. Place one 2 1/2" **Fabric F** square on the left side of one 2 1/2" x 12 1/2" **Fabric C** rectangle, right sides together. (Diagram 3) Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner. (Diagram 3) Flip open the triangle formed and press. (Diagram 4) Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.




- 4. Place one 2 1/2" **Fabric F** square on the right side of the 2 1/2" x 12 1/2" **Fabric C** rectangle, right sides together. (Diagram 5) Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner. (Diagram 5) Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make one Unit 1 rectangle. (Diagram 6)
- Repeat Steps 3-4 to make an additional twentythree Unit 1 rectangles.




- 6. Sew together four 2 1/2" **Fabric D** squares and three Unit 1 rectangles, end to end and alternating them from left to right, to make Row One. (Diagram 7) Repeat to make Row Three, Row Five and Row Seven.
- 7. Sew together four Unit 1 rectangles and three Block One squares, alternating them from left to right, to make Row Two. (Diagram 7) Repeat to make Row Six.
- 8. Sew together four Unit 1 rectangles, two Block One squares and one Block Two square as shown to make Row Four. (Diagram 7)
- 9. Sew together the seven pieced Rows, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the 44 1/2" x 44 1/2" Quilt Center. (Diagram 7)




10. Place one 3" Fabric F square on top of one 3" Fabric E square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square. (Diagram 8) Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line. (Diagram 8) Cut the two squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 9) to make two half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 2 1/2" to make two Unit 2 squares. (Diagram 10) Repeat to make an additional fourteen Unit 2 squares.



- Paying attention to the unit orientations, sew together four Unit 2 squares and three
  1/2" x 12 1/2" Fabric E rectangles to make the
  1/2" x 44 1/2" Left Side Border. (Diagram 11)
  Repeat to make the Right Side Border. (Diagram 12)
- 12. Sew together two 2 1/2" **Fabric E** squares, four Unit 2 squares and three 2 1/2" x 12 1/2" **Fabric E** rectangles as shown to make the 2 1/2" x 48 1/2" Top Border. (Diagram 13) Repeat to make the Bottom Border. (Diagram 14)






## Quilt Assembly:

- 13. Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the left and right sides of the Quilt Center. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Quilt Center.
- 14. Sew one 2" x 48 1/2" **Fabric E** strip to each side of the Quilt Center. Sew one 2" x 51 1/2" **Fabric E** strip to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center.
- 15. Pay attention the orientation of the Fabric B strips. Sew one 5 1/2" x 51 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of the Quilt Center. Sew one 5 1/2" x 61 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center to make the quilt top.

## Finishing:

- 16. Prepare backing using two widths of fabric. Press seams open. Trim to 69" x 69".
- 17. Layer the quilt, batting and backing. Baste layers together.
- 18. Quilt as desired.
- 19. Trim layers even with quilt top, squaring corners.
- 20. Attach 2 1/2" **Fabric E** binding strips using your favorite method.
